

Waardegedrewe suigstokkies

Hierdie jaar gaan Vaalpark Primêre Skool weereens die sewe waardes van die skool aan ons leerders oordra. Ons het dit goedgevind om dit bietjie interessant vir die leerders te maak.

Ons gaan dit doen, deur gekleurde (waardekleure) suigstokkies aan die kinders te verkoop @ R3 elk. In kwartaal 1 gaan ons een suigstokkie hê en in die ander drie kwartale, twee suigstokkies per kwartaal. Ouers betaal die R21 op die Karri-App. Bestellings sal Maandae sluit. Die leerders sal hul suigstokkie, Woensdae-en Donderdae-oggende in registerperiode ontvang. Hy /sy moet hierdie stokkie by hul hou, maar mag hom nog nie eet nie. Mnr. Erasmus sal deur die loop van daardie dag vir hul laat weet, wanneer hul die suigstokkie mag eet. Dit kan enige tyd van die dag wees, selfs in klastyd en dan mag die leerders die suigstokkie oopmaak en eet.

Hierdie dae sal dan gebruik word om weer met die kinders, daardie betrokke waarde te hanteer, in die klas. Leerders kan ophierdie dae, gekleurde of snaakse kouse saam hul skoolklere aantrek.

Ons eerste suigstokkie gaan op, Woensdag en Donderdag, 7 – 8 April wees.

“Value Driven” Lollipops

This year Vaalpark Primary is going to re-inforce our 7 values to our learners. We want to make this activity interesting for the learners. We are going to sell different coloured Lollipops @ R3-00 each, representing each value. On the same Wednesday or Thursday, re-enforcement of that week's particular value will be done, and explained in class.

In term 1 we will have one lollipop and in the other 3 terms, two lollipops per term. Parents pay the total R21 on the Karri App. Orders will close on Mondays. The learners will receive their lollipop on that Wednesday/Thursday morning during the register period. He / she must keep this lollipop with them, but may not eat it straight away. During the course of the day, Mr Erasmus will announce when the learners may eat. It could be any time of the day! Even during class periods. Then only can they open them and eat them.

These “lolliepop” days will be used to share the respective value with the children during class. Learners can wear colourful, or funny socks, with their school clothes, on “lollie-value” day.

The first “lollie-value” day will be on, Wednesday and Thursday, 7 – 8 April.
